I used to want to get off work so I could go get high; now I just want to get back to work... and because of your donations and prayers I'm about ready to do just that. After 21 years of drug use, all I got in return was stress, despair and disappointment. In spite of my use of drugs, I was always successful in real estate, with big checks coming in all the time. I was living the good life, or so I thought. Trouble was my finances weren't keeping up with my habit.

Whenever there was a choice between buying food and buying drugs, I always went for the drugs. Ultimately, the drugs won the day...that is, up until now.

Thank you for your support, which is helping to give me peace of mind.

Today, because I'm at the Durham Rescue Mission, everything has changed in my life. I am grateful for the food, clothing and a roof over my head. But there's something even more important to me, and that's peace of mind. I used to think drugs were making me happy. How wrong I was. I now know what I should have known many years ago: that I needed a Savior to rescue me. I also see why I could never enjoy true success on my own. I was designed to be God's child, and I know He has a plan for me.

And some of those plans are already beginning to take shape. I have 20 notebooks full of real estate ideas. Here at the Mission I'm able to use the computer lab, where I'm working on my resume.

I'm lining up lots of interviews, and I'm eager to get back into the real estate field. But none of this would have been possible were it not for a loving God, a compassionate Mission and a friend like you who is giving me the confidence to return to society. Thank you and God bless you.


We thank God for you and your heart of compassion for the homeless... and for so many others who've lost their way.
